Please Review the rules for KRVHSA shows:

1. **Walk Jog & 3 Gate may not cross enter.**
2. **All ages are of January 1st.**
3. **Junior Horse is 5 & Under.**
4. **Senior Horse is 6 & Older.**
5. **Must be 21 or older to handle studs. If studs become unruly you will be asked to remove stud from premises.**
6. **Lead line class is for young riders incapable of riding on their own.**
7. **In hand trail entry may not be ridden in the trail classes.**
8. **Western attire: jeans or chaps (optional), button up long sleeve shirt, boots, belt, hat or helmet. ASHA approved.**
9. **English attire: breeches, English button up, hunt coat (optional), belt, English boots, English bit and saddle. ASHA approved.**
10. **\$50.00 fee to be eligible for year end awards. No pay, no awards.**
11. **Participation Awards are given for entering in 4 shows, no less then three classes per show. Perfect participation is all 5 shows, no less then three classes per show.**
12. **Classes are \$8.00 each or \$45 all day, \$40 if mailed early.**
13. **Cleanliness is important.**
14. **Please be prompt to your class.**
15. **All horses entered in any class must be well mannered or will be excused from the arena and/or show grounds at the discretion of the show judge/management.**
16. **Good sportsmanship is required to participate.**
 - a. **Horseshow management has the right to ask anyone to leave the premises.**
17. **Judges decisions are final.**
 - a. **You may ask a judge how to improve your placement for the next show or why you placed as you did but do not criticize a judges decision.**

******* Beginner Classes: These classes cater to our Lead Liners: Contestants cannot enter any other class and have not shown the previous year in W/J**

Awards

Day Awards: Each show day will give out ribbons 1st to 5th place for each class. Rosette will be presented to Grand Halter, W/J High point, Beginner High Point, 16 & Under High point, 17-39 High point and 40 & Over High Point.

2018 Year End Awards: .

The Highest Award is given to Versatility High Point. This is the most points earned (Overall High Point). This is based on the person who enters the most classes, wins the most in each age division and attends the most shows.

Champion Halter: The horse receives the award regardless of who shows the horse. Grand Champion Points will go towards Halter Year End.

Awards will be presented to Western All Around, English Overall, and Trail All Around. Equitation and Pleasure to towards English and Western Overall. **Reining, Jr & Sr Horse and Country Pleasure do not count towards points**

Participation Awards are given for entering in 4 shows and paying year end award fee. Perfect participation—all 5 shows.
